## WELCOME TO OUR AUTUMN 2015 PRAYER DIARY!

Last autumn we had a special emphasis on prayer for the persecuted church around the world. This autumn our emphasis is upon that absolute necessity of the work of the Holy Spirit to empower our personal lives, cell ministry and global outreach.

Every day we must think, live, pray and act knowing that it is:

"Not by might, not by power, but by my Spirit," says the Lord of Hosts. (Zechariah 4:6)

#### Prayer diary and daily Bible reading plan

It is also absolutely imperative that we spend time with the Word and the Spirit on a daily basis and this prayer diary has a daily Bible reading plan that will take us right to the end of January 2016.



This prayer diary is to fuel concentrated prayer at four levels of our church:

#### 1. PERSONAL DAILY PRAYER AND BIBLE READING

Every day we will be reading through the Bible together and praying for a particular aspect of our life and ministry.

#### 2. CELL MINISTRY

Cell leaders will encourage and monitor the use of this prayer diary in the life of the cell members and also use it for prayer in their cell meetings.

#### 3. WEDNESDAY EVENING PRAYER GATHERINGS

The prayer diary will be used as fuel for our regular Wednesday 7pm prayer gathering.

The pages before the prayer diary and the Bible reading plan will highlight some specific areas that I believe we need concentrated prayer for the coming autumn season.

Let us raise the levels of devotion, prayer and study of God's Word. This is the foundation upon which all God's plans for us depend.









This prayer diary gives you fuel for prayer about the areas God is putting on our heart. We believe that God has called our church to a special season of prayer for global revival and especially for revival in Europe and the Great Britain. Let stories about what God is doing in other nations strengthen and inspire you to pray for an open heaven in our nation and Europe!

The prayer diary covers each day from 1st October 2015 to 31st January 2016.

We maintain an equal emphasis on the Spirit and the Word, and we want you to stay firmly rooted in the Word. The Bible reading plan in the end of the diary helps you read through the whole Bible in a year.



I have been in Christian ministry for more than thirty years. From time to time. I have known moments and even seasons of what I can only describe as 'an open heaven'. When this happens, it seems as if there is nothing between us and heaven nothing blocking our communion. nothing hindering the flow of God's love and glory, and nothing to stop God pouring out his blessing in fullness. At times like these people are drawn to Christ by the hundreds and we witness many outstanding miracles of healing and deliverance. I can only describe it as revival.

Revival essentially is an open heaven. It is when God 'comes down' and manifests his glory. It is when he reveals himself in all his splendour and fullness. Our hearts begin to burn with his passion, set on fire by his incandescent nature. We catch alight like combustible material in the midst of roaring fire. And yet, by his mercies we are not consumed! Instead, ignited with his glory we become charged with his power and offer our lives totally to him as our only Lord and God. Laying everything before him, we overcome our resistance until our will becomes completely his.

At the close of the twentieth century there was a deepening awareness of God visiting his people once again. There was much talk of revival. Many churches in Britain held nightly revival services and thousands from all over Europe gathered to seek God and get right with him. Personal revival came to many eager-hearted seekers. But these revivals were meant to move us into a time of harvest.

And with that came our emphasis on mobilisation of the body of Christ through the principles of cell church. The cells are where hungry believers pray, call out for souls to be saved and are discipled, becoming actively involved in God's work. All this leads me to believe that, regardless of the negative headlines, Europe's time has come. God is about to move in revival proportions across our nations. Personal revival will become corporate revival and reformation.

But, if we are to see that, we must go back to basics and understand once again the true nature of revival. Revival is an open heaven. It is a manifestation of the glory of God. It is a holy visitation of the divine presence. But we must look for even more than this. God's will is not just for holy visitation, but holy habitation. He doesn't want to come to visit. He wants to come to stay! That's the birthright of the church of Jesus Christ, as Paul says,

"...in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit."

(Ephesians 2:22)

**Pray for** fruitfulness and multiplication in our cell vision along with the wisdom and humility to be able to handle it.

Pray for a fresh visitation of the Holy Spirit upon us all.

### GLOBAL REVIVAL WHERE GOD IS MOVING TODAY

#### Reflecting the physical destruction, after World War 2 Europe has been a spiritual wasteland.

But God is moving in unexpected ways around the world, and we should take courage from that here in Europe. If God is moving in nations whose spiritual state used to be, and still is, lot more desperate than Europe's, then surely we also must have hope!

#### MILLIONS IN IRAN FIND JESUS

It might be hard to believe that, today, Iran has one of the fastest growing Christian populations in the world.

It is difficult to estimate how many Christians there are in Iran, as most of the churches gather secretly, but it is evident that there are 1-7 million Christians in Iran. This is a nation in a desperate need of God – according to anti-narcotics officials at least 2.2 million Iranians are drug addicts.

But more Iranians have come to Christ in the last 35 years since the Islamic Revolution than in the prior 1,400 years combined! And most of these conversions have occurred in the past decade, as an estimated 62 million Iranians have gained access to the gospel message through satellite TV broadcasts.



#### **PRAYER FUEL**

**Pray for** God's blessing, favour and protection over millions of Iranians who have found hope and salvation in Jesus.

Pray for religious liberty to increase in Iran, so that the underground churches would be able to worship visibly and be a greater witness in society.

Pray that God would bless and resource all the Internet and TV ministries that are working to make the Good News available in Farsi for Iranians.

#### ALGERIAN CHRISTIANS TO SEND 1,000 MISSIONARIES

CBN News reported on 22nd August 2015 about the move of God in the predominantly Muslim nations of Mauritania, Western Sahara, Morocco, Libya and Tunisia that is now touching Algeria – a nation where KT is resourcing churches.

Pastor Salah leads one of the largest churches in Algeria. Some 1,200 believers attend the church. Nearly every Christian in his church has come from a Muslim background. Since the church opened, they have baptised on average 150-160 believers every year.

Even though Algeria is overwhelmingly Muslim, the government has given Protestant churches the freedom to register their congregations.

"It is the first Muslim Arab government that recognises, officially, churches from Islam," Youssef Qurahmane, a leading Algerian pastor, told CBN News.

The arrival of satellite TV and the Internet have dramatically changed people's perception of Christianity, and this is the work we have been able to be part of through Colin's Sword of the Spirit programmes on KingdomSat.

Another Arabic Christian channel has around 40 million viewers each week all across the Middle East. In 2014, the channel received over 13 million messages or phone calls from Arabs hungry for the Good News.

"God has put in our heart to be able to send 1,000 missionaries by the year 2025," Pastor Qurahmane told CBN News.



#### **//** PRAYER FUEL

Pray that the vision about 1,000 Algerian missionaries by 2025 would be fulfilled.

Pray for finances for our programmes on KingdomSat, as they are also available to millions of people in Algeria.

Pray that God would protect the Algerian churches, Christians and pastors from violent Islamic extremism.

**Pray for** the establishment of full religious freedom in Algeria.

#### CHINA SOON THE WORLD'S MOST CHRISTIAN NATION

The *Telegraph* of 19th April 2014 reported that the number of Christians in Communist China is growing so fast that by 2030 China is projected to have more churchgoers than America.

"By my calculations China is destined to become the largest Christian country in the world very soon," said Fenggang Yang, a professor of sociology at Purdue University and author of *Religion in China*: Survival and Revival under Communist Rule.

"It is going to be less than a generation. Not many people are prepared for this dramatic change."

In 2010 there were more than 58 million Protestants in China compared to 40 million in Brazil and 36 million in South Africa, according to the Pew Research Centre's Forum on Religion and Public Life.

By 2030, China's total Christian population, including Catholics, would exceed 247 million, placing it above Mexico, Brazil and the United States as the largest Christian congregation in the world, Yang predicted.





**Pray that** persecution of Christians would end in all China.

Pray for prominent and theologically sound Chinese teaching ministries to arise.

Pray that the increasing prosperity of China wouldn't make Chinese Christians lukewarm, but that they would export their zeal for the Lord worldwide.

#### **CUBA RISING**

The *Guardian* of Friday 12th June 2015 reported about the revival of Christianity in Cuba. The island has experienced a religious revival in the past 25 years. Cuba was never a deeply Christian country, unlike many other nations in the region. But the Catholic Church and evangelical churches have come a long way from the 1960s and 70s, when Christians were sent to labour camps.

Today, Christmas and Good Friday are national holidays. Churchgoers no longer face official discrimination. And evangelical churches are growing fast. For example, the Methodist church of Marianao in Havana had fewer than 400 members fifteen years ago, but has more than 3,200 today.

It is noteworthy that secular media in Britain is reporting of revivals around the world whereas much of the European Church is depressed because of the perceived malaise of the Church!



#### **PRAYER FUEL**

Pray that the evangelical churches in Cuba would remain doctrinally pure, as some of them are also taking elements from Santería, a form of spirit worship that blends African deities with Catholic saints.

Pray for all religious persecution to end in Cuba, and that the government would allow new churches to be built.

Pray for the growth of the over 6,500 house churches in Cuba.

#### THE PERILOUS STATE OF EUROPE

There are some surprising stories of church growth and churches affecting society in Europe, such as the growth of Faith Church in Hungary with over 300 local church branches and 70,000 members, and Embassy of God led by Nigerian Sunday Adelaja with over 25,000 members in Kiev, Ukraine and hundreds of daughter churches around Europe. Rather interestingly, many of these churches are now in the formerly communist part of Europe whose spiritual state was abysmal until the early 1990s.

But by and large, Europe has been a spiritual wasteland for decades. We must pray that, as the 500th anniversary of the Reformation will be celebrated in 2017, that God would trigger a new reformation and revival in Europe before it!

Francis A. Schaeffer writes in his book *The Church Before the Watching World* about the spiritual adultery and apostasy of the Western Church.

"Now, let us notice where we have come. When those who claim to be God's people turn aside from the Word of God and from the Christ of history, this is more heinous in the sight of God than the worst case of infidelity in marriage, for it destroys the reality, the great central bridegroombride relationship. God does not minimize promiscuity in sexual relationships, but apostasy – spiritual adultery – is worse. And many modern theologians are in that place. How do we look at it? I would



suggest we must be careful to look at it no less clearly than God does. It denies the personal God who is there. It denies the divine historic Christ. It denies the Bible as God's verbalized Word. It denies God's way of salvation. They elevate their own humanistic theories to a position above the Word of God, the revealed communication of God to men. They make gods which are no gods, but are merely the projection of their own minds."

Schaeffer's book was published in 1972, but it is difficult to describe the state of the Church in Europe more precisely.

It was in Europe where the absolute truths of God's Word were made relative and the Church was nearly mortally weakened. It was in Europe where man became God's judge.

The prophecy of the apostle Paul can easily be applied to the European Church:

"But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, having a form of godliness but denying its power."

(2 Tim. 3:1-5)

But all hope is not lost, as we serve the Living God! In his book *Revival Phenomena* Colin defines revival as a "season of powerful visitation from God." He adds, "As far as I am concerned, revival is

essentially a manifestation of God. It is a time when he reveals himself both in his absolute holiness and in his great power."

"There will come a revival to this church which will go all over London, all over Britain and all over Europe. This revival will touch all kinds of nations, all kinds of nationalities and all kinds of ethnic groups."



The February 2000 edition of Revival Times recounts the visit of Dr Emanuel Minos to KT. He was a Norwegian evangelist and friend of George Jeffreys, the founder of the Elim Pentecostal Church who also gave our church its current name. Dr Minos tells about an incident during his first visit to KT in 1949 when a KT elder approached him, and said, "Just before you arrived some days ago, there was a mighty prophecy in this church about what shall happen in the latter days, just before the second coming of Christ... And in this prophecy it came, that there will come a revival to this church which will go all over London, all over Britain and all over Europe. This revival will touch all kinds of nations, all kinds of nationalities and all kinds of ethnic groups."

Dr Minos says, "This came in 1949 when there were very few immigrants in Britain, very few at that time, and when this message came, some thought it was a little remarkable and a little odd. But when the revival comes this church will be filled with people from all over the commonwealth, all over the world together with English people and that revival will go all over the world afterwards and it will happen just before Jesus is coming the second time."



Pray that a new reformation would begin to break forth in Europe before the 500th anniversary of the Reformation on 31st October 2017.

Pray that the prophecy about the revival going from KT to all over Europe would come to pass in its fullness.

Pray for revival in all our churches in Britain and Europe and in our partner organisations and churches in Europe.

Pray that the defeatist spirit over the British and European churches would be broken, so that Christians would be able to see the future of the Church in Europe with faith.

Pray for unity in the real Body of Christ in Europe to increase.

Pray that God would restore faith in the Bible in Europe.

Pray that God would anoint the Church in Europe with sign and wonders – and with love.

#### **EVANGELISM OF 3**

Unless we keep evangelism as our primary purpose, the cell groups easily slip into the comfort of Christian fellowship meetings only. And evangelism is what sustains any revival movement.

That is why we centre all cell group activity on what we call the Evangelism of 3. Prayer triplets are not new, but they are an effective way of involving every single cell member to win people to Christ.

We begin by asking cell members to make a list of up to ten people whom they know, meet regularly and can invite to the cell meetings. Then we focus on three people the Holy Spirit shows us on each of these lists. Joining with two or three other people, we begin to pray daily for those on our shortlists. Regular cell meetings will include time for prayer and strategic planning, in order to win these precious people for Christ. The cells then organise

their meetings and activities around the goal of reaching their friends with the gospel.

Write down up to ten names of people you are in regular contact with in London that don't know Christ and pray for their salvation each day.

#### DAILY PRAYER PLAN

**DAY 1:** Pray for Colin and Amanda Dye and all the leaders of KTLCC for unity, strength and clarity of vision, wisdom and success. Don't forget to fill in your daily prayer for the Evangelism of 3 (see pages 15-16).

Read the article 'What is revival?' by Colin Dye on pages 4-5. Pray for an 'open heaven' over your life and the ministry of KT. Ask the Holy Spirit to rest upon and abide with us in great power, presence and holiness.

**DAY 2:** Pray for all Christians involved in politics and education and especially those involved in the newly launched KT forums. Pray for the Prime Minister and the Government, the Mayor of London and also for your local government. Follow the news today and pray regarding anything important going on in Parliament.

Read the article 'What is revival?' by Colin Dye on pages 4-5. Pray for an 'open heaven' over your life and the ministry of KT. Ask the Holy Spirit to rest upon and abide with us in great power, presence and holiness.

**DAY 3:** Pray for the ministry and power of the Holy Spirit to increase in our cells, churches and all our missions work. Pray for new Open-Cells that are being launched that they would win and consolidate many new believers. Pray for an explosive multiplication of new cell leaders and cells.

Evan Roberts, leader of the Welsh Revival prayed famously, "Oh Lord, bend me". Pray for the same attitude in your own life.

**DAY 4:** Pray for a revival to come in all the churches of London and upon all Christian leaders in all denominations in London. Pray that God would guide them and us, and use them for his glory. Pray especially for the cell leaders and church leaders of KTLCC.

Read about the move of God in Iran on page 8 and use the highlighted prayer fuel.

**DAY 5:** Pray for all the young adults, youth and children in KTLCC that God would pour out his Holy Spirit upon them, and baptise them with a fresh encounter of power and holiness.

Pray that the prophetic promise on page 7 about the glory of this latter house being greater than that of the former would come to pass.

**DAY 6:** Pray for all Christians in prominent public and media positions. Pray that they will be filled with the Holy Spirit and become Daniels, Esthers, Josephs and Nehemiahs! Pray especially for all KT people involved in these sectors.

Read the quote by John Calvin on page 6. Pray for all the non-Christians that you know you will meet today and let the Holy Spirit lead intercession for them. See what the Lord will do in response this very day!

DAY 7: Pray for the persecuted church in Northern Nigeria – for strength and deliverance from Boko Haram terrorists. Pray for the Nigerian government to be stable and to address the persecution. Pray for the church in the South to remember the church in the North and help them. Pray for the spirit of discipleship to prevail over the rising false, materialistic gospel.

Read about the move of God in Algeria and pray using the prayer fuel on page 9.

**DAY 8:** Pray for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the French-speaking world. Especially, pray for a revival in the nation of Mali where there has been much persecution.

On page 5 Colin writes that revival is "a holy visitation of the divine presence." Pray for this presence to come in your life and the life of KT. Pray that there will be a Holy Spirit visitation that will become an abiding habitation!

**DAY 9:** Pray for our TV ministry that reaches millions in North Africa, the Middle East and Indonesia. Pray for the new programmes we want to produce in Arabic. Pray for a move of the Holy Spirit that would convert millions of Muslims in the next few years worldwide. Pray for the true nature of Islam and the Qur'an to be revealed in the media and in politics.

Read and use the prayer fuel on page 10 regarding the moving of the Holy Spirit in China.

**DAY 10:** Pray for the Elim Pentecostal churches across Britain, of which we are part that we would multiply and be effective for the gospel. Pray for the National Leadership Team that they would have the mind of the Spirit in leading our movement forward.

Pray that the prophecy by Canon James Wong regarding KT on page 7 would come to pass.

**DAY 11:** Pray for marriages and families in our nation. Pray that the biblical view of marriage and the family would be strengthened in our nation. Pray for all marriages and families in KTLCC. Pray for God's grace to be with all single parents and their children in our church. Pray also for singles seeking to find their life partner.

Read about the move of God in Cuba and pray according to the prayer fuel on page 11.

**DAY 12:** Pray for the preaching and teaching of KTLCC. Ask God to give great revelation, authority and anointing in the pulpit of our house to break strongholds, set captives free, and release people into their destiny. Pray for the preachers that you know in our network. Pray for God's blessing to be on Dr R.T. Kendall as he joins us again for six months in February. Pray that he would bring us a word in season.

Pray using the prophetic prayer fuel on page 7.

**DAY 13:** Pray for all our members working in medicine and healthcare. Pray that God's love and healing would flow through their words and actions. Pray for the end of abortion on demand and that our nation would understand that life starts at conception. Pray against proposed legislation for assisted suicide and euthanasia that would put many vulnerable people at risk.

Read the article 'The perilous state of Europe' on pages 12-14 and use the prayer fuel on page 14.

**DAY 14:** When Christianity spread into Europe for the first time, it was spearheaded with genuine signs and wonders. Pray for the restoration of signs and wonders, and gifts of the Spirit in the Church of Europe across all denominations.

Read the article 'The perilous state of Europe' on pages 12-14 and use the prayer fuel on page 14.

**DAY 15:** Lift up all KT street outreach teams and local London missions to the throne of God. Pray for all Open-Cell outreaches that our unsaved friends would become brothers and sisters in Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Pray for the Church in Europe as increasing pressure and persecution arises from secularism and Islamic sources. Pray for a breakthrough for the gospel in Europe and for a new Reformation to take place.

**DAY 16:** Pray that the vision given to us in the 1980s that people would come to KT as hearers of the Word and go out into the world as doers of the Word would come to pass. Pray for our cell vision to be recharged with a fresh anointing of the Holy Spirit.

**DAY 17:** Pray for all the students at IBIOL that God would prepare them for the ministry. Pray for a Holy Spirit encounter for those attending Tuesday night training. Pray for the members of New Believers' Groups meeting in the KT Lower Hall on Tuesdays that the Holy Spirit would establish each one of them in the faith.

On pages 4-5 Colin writes of being set on fire as our hearts burn with the Holy Spirit of revival. Pray that you will catch the fire of the Holy Spirit!

**DAY 18:** Pray especially for all your family, friends and loved ones. Ask the Holy Spirit to show you some needs that they have that you can pray for.

John Knox prayed, "Give me Scotland or I die!" Pray that God will raise us up with a similar passion and single-mindedness.

**DAY 19:** Pray for our cell vision and for a stirring of passion amongst us to make and mature disciples. Pray that the prophecy by Canon James Wong for KT would come to pass: "For Kensington Temple to reach its destiny with God it must become the greatest disciple making centre in London."

**DAY 20:** Pray for all Christians involved in medicine, health and the care sector of society that God would use them to show the love of God for all in need.

Read about the visit of Dr Minos to KT on page 14. Pray that the prophecy a KT elder shared with him about our destiny as a church would come to pass.

**DAY 21:** Pray for supernatural resources to be released for the ministry of KTLCC. Pray for millions of pounds to be released for the gospel work of KT. Pray for all KT members looking for jobs that are struggling with finances that God would show them a way into blessing.

Speak in other tongues for at least ten minutes.

**DAY 22:** Pray for a new generation of leaders in the Church of Europe to arise that would turn the tide of unbelief and bring forth revival. Pray that God would use KT to help bring revival to London, Europe and the world.

**DAY 23:** Pray for an increase in the manifestation of the nine gifts of the Spirit amongst us (1 Cor. 12:4). Pray also for a corresponding work of the Spirit in our lives producing the nine fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22).

Pray through the prayer lines regarding Cuba on page 11.

**DAY 24:** Pray for your cell leader and any other members of your cell group. Ask the Lord for words of encouragement to give to them today. Speak, text or email the encouragement to them straight away.

Pray through the prayer lines regarding China on page 10.

**DAY 25:** Pray for the fivefold ministry to emerge even stronger through our cells in KTLCC this year. Pray that the people in cells would be prepared for ministry. Choose two of the fivefold ministries, and pray especially for their manifestation in our cells and churches (Eph. 4:11).

**DAY 26:** Pray for the worship life of the church that many worship teams would arise from the cell ministry, for new songs for the house, and for a powerful priestly anointing on all our worship both in cells and in the services.

**DAY 27:** Pray for all our members working in the areas of business and finance. Pray that God would use them for his glory and to bring wealth to fund the gospel.

Use the prayer fuel on page 8 to pray for Iran.

17TH OCTOBER

**DAY 28:** Pray for the KT services on Sundays and Wednesday evenings. Pray for all the teams that minister faithfully each Sunday. Pray for each service to be filled to capacity!

**DAY 29:** Pray for all Elim Pentecostal churches in Great Britain that God would pour out his Holy Spirit upon them all and guide us into greater unity, power and love.

Use the prayer fuel on page 14 and pray for Europe.

**DAY 30:** Pray the Lord's Prayer and forgive all those who have trespassed against you. Pray for God's blessing on their lives.

Read the article 'What is revival?' on pages 4-5, and ask the Lord to speak personally to you through it today.

**DAY 31:** Give thanks to God for all he did in your life this month. Name every blessing that God gave to you in the last month and thank him for them. Give thanks for every person in your cell. Give thanks for what he is about to do in you and through you in the next month.

Pray for the Church in Europe as increasing pressure and persecution arises from secularism and Islamic sources. Pray for a breakthrough for the gospel in Europe and for a new Reformation to take place.


