Future donations

- If your declaration covers donation(s) you may make in future:
 - please notify Kensington Temple if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force.
 - you can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying Kensington Temple. It will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later dates as you specify. Please deliver your cancellation in writing to the Finance Department.
- You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that Kensington Temple reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give)

Cancellation of a Gift Aid declaration

- If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to or greater than the tax that K.T. reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note1).

Higher rate tax payers

- If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief on your Self Assessment tax return.

Lower rate tax payers

- If you pay less than £180 per year in tax, you are a lower rate (starter rate) tax payer. The Chancellor has agreed that you can now give under Gift Aid Declaration and we can reclaim tax up to the amount of tax paid by you. In fact, you can donate up to £3.50 for every £1 tax you pay.
