As believers we are not only part of the local church but also the global church made up of every believer throughout the world. On the day of Pentecost the early church received power to be witnesses not only in Jerusalem but also in Samaria and indeed to the ends of the earth (Acts1:8). God wants us not just to be local believers but global missionaries in our praying, giving and going.

For us at KT London is our Jerusalem, Britain and Europe our Samaria, and the world awaits us too. Our 119 different nationalities and major ethnic groups make us one of the most international churches in the World. The world is part of our KT DNA! This summer we will be focusing on looking out to the global harvest in our prayer diary, not only to the missions projects we as a church are particularly involved in but also the wider global harvest that is currently taking place.

DAILY BIBLE READING PLAN

It is important that we are in the Word and the Spirit every day and this prayer diary has a daily Bible reading plan that will take us right through to the end of September.

This prayer diary is to fuel concentrated prayer at four levels of our church:

I Personal daily prayer and Bible reading

Every day we will be reading through the Bible together and praying for a particular aspect of our life and ministry.

II Cell ministry

Cell leaders will encourage and monitor the use of this prayer diary in the life of the cell members and also use it for prayer in their cell meetings.

III Early Morning Prayer meetings

Early Morning Prayer meetings are held at Kensington Temple at 6.30am-8.30am every Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Leaders from our KTLCC Network host these meetings and will use the Summer Missions Prayer Diary to help concentrate and fuel our prayers.

IV Wednesday Evening Prayer meetings/Monthly half night of prayer.

The prayer diary will be used as fuel for our regular Wednesday prayer meeting along with the Wednesday monthly half night of prayer.

The pages before the Prayer Diary and Bible reading plan will highlight some specific areas that I believe we need concentrated prayer for in the coming summer season.

Let us raise the levels of devotion, prayer and study of God's Word. This is the foundation upon which all God's plans for us depend!

PRAYER FUEL FOR SUMMER 2014

Praying for souls to be saved

We cannot expect to see the lost saved and become committed disciples without much intercession. Quite simply, we are very unlikely to see the hurting healed and the lost rescued without persistent, prevailing prayer.

Evangelistic praying

The New Testament reveals that the apostle Paul was a tremendous man of prayer; and his letters are filled with prayers for his readers. The Scriptures also show that Paul was passionate about evangelism – so we should not be surprised to find that most of his recorded prayer requests and prayers were made to facilitate effective evangelism.

"Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved" (Romans 10:1).

Romans 10:1 describes Paul's dearest wish for the Jews. This verse teaches nothing about the *content* of his praying; rather, it reveals the *purpose* of his praying. Romans 10:1 encourages fervent evangelistic prayer, but it does not provide a model prayer for us to use.

Paul seems to have prayed, and to have requested prayer, for his own ministry by interceding that the obstacles preventing his evangelism would be removed, and that he would be equipped, energised and motivated to witness more effectively.

This suggests that, when we long for someone to be saved, we will wrestle in prayer to bring about their salvation. Like Paul, we will spend long hours praying with the purpose that they will be saved. We will, however, want to find the most effective way of praying to bring about their salvation. Paul's epistles suggest that effective evangelistic prayer often has two distinct elements:

1. Prayer for heralds to be motivated, empowered and equipped

2. Prayer for obstacles blocking salvation to be removed.

MISSIONS FAITH DECLARATION

Declare from the heart each day before prayer:

I am anointed with God's own Holy Spirit, and I have been set apart for the Master's personal use.

I am a vessel of His honour and His holy treasure abides in an earthen vessel. The excellency of the power belongs entirely to God.

To Him be all the praise and honour, by Christ Jesus my Lord.

- I confess and declare that I am called by Almighty God to be a witness to Jesus, to be a fisher of men, to be a disciple-maker, to be a church-builder.
 - I will fully obey this calling, depending at all times on the anointing and enabling of the Spirit.

I am my brother and sister's keeper.

I am wholly committed to the body of Christ.

I am a constant encourager.

I have renounced all criticism and negative speaking.

I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of salvation.

I long for all hurting people to experience Christ's saving love, and I take every opportunity to speak about Him.

I hereby dedicate myself completely to the ministry of Jesus, and will serve Him zealously for the rest of my earthly days.

To Him be all praise and glory forever. Amen.

EVANGELISM OF 3

Unless we keep evangelism as our primary purpose, the cell groups easily slip into the comfort of Christian fellowship meetings.

That is why we centre all cell group activity on what we call the Evangelism of 3. Prayer triplets are not new, but they are an effective way of involving every single cell member to win people to Christ.

We begin by asking cell members to make a list of 10 people whom they know, meet regularly and can invite to the cell meetings. Then we focus on 3 people the Holy Spirit shows us on each of these lists. Joining with 2 or 3 other people, we begin to pray daily for those on our shortlists. Regular cell meetings will include time for prayer and strategic planning, in order to win these precious people for Christ. The cells then organise their meetings and activities around the goal of reaching their friends with the gospel.


Write down up to ten names of people you are in regular contact with in London that don't know Christ and pray for their salvation each day.



PRAYING FOR WORLD EVANGELISM!

The State of the World - Lausanne Missions Report

The Centre for the Study of Global Christianity released a report in 2013 called *Christianity in its Global Context 1970 - 2020 Society, Religion and Mission*. Christians around the world today find themselves in very different contexts than they did 40 years ago when the Lausanne Movement was founded. The key findings of this report are arranged according to the Edinburgh 1910 Lausanne Movement motto, which is *'The Whole Church, Taking The Whole Gospel, To The Whole World'*.

The Whole Church

The whole Church includes all Christians and we count 2.3 billion, in all Christian traditions, Roman Catholic, Orthodox, independent etc. There were 18,800 Christian denominations in the world in 1970 and this number had risen to 41,000 by 2010. We anticipate by 2020 this number will have risen to 50,000 Christian denominations.

The shift to the global South has also been well documented. In 1970 41.3% of all Christians lived in Africa, Asia and Latin America and by 2020 this figure is expected to be 64.7%. Between 1970 and 2020 each of the major Christian traditions is expected to grow more rapidly than the general population in the global South. A third major trend happening in the whole Church is the growth of Pentecostal and Evangelical movements.

Pentecostals, Charismatics and Independent Charismatics have grown at nearly four times the growth rate of global Christianity. In 1970 these Christians represented 5% of global Christianity but today they represent 26%. As far as Evangelicalism goes, there were about 98 million Evangelicals in 1970 and over 300 million today.

The Whole Gospel

In terms of the preaching of the gospel, the number of unevangelized individuals in the world has remained high but relative to the percentage of the world's population. The number of unevangelized individuals was estimated at 1.8 billion in 1970 which was 44% of the world's population. So when Lausanne first started in 1974 44% of the world was considered unevangelized. By 2010 this number rose to 2 billion but the percentage dropped to 29% of the global population. It is estimated that there will be 2.2 billion unevangelized individuals by 2020. So, even though population



growth is increasing, it is outpaced by evangelistic efforts and the percentage of unevangelized individuals is dropping.

The Whole World

The percentage of the world that was religious continues to increase. In 1970 around 80% of the world's population was religious. By 2010 this had risen to 88% and by 2020 we estimate that 90% of the world will be religious. Ths represents a huge change from the context of 1970, which was the demographic height of atheistic and agonistic population in the world. In addition, in 1970 Christianity and Islam together represented 49% of the global population but by 2020 we estimate that they will likely represent 57%. So Christianity and Islam continue to be the two largest religions in the world but Islam is growing at a faster rate in many places.

Personal Contact

Another key issue is personal contact between Christians and followers of other religions. It's estimated that 81% of all people in the world do not personally know a Christian from any tradition. This is most prominent in overwhelming Muslim majority countries and so on a regional level only 10% of people in Western Asia are thought to have personal contact with a Christian.

PRAYER REPORTS FROM THE LAUSANNE MISSIONS REPORT

Global

South Sudan

- Every day around 40,000 people across the globe come to faith in Christ.
- An average of 3,500 new churches open every week around the world.
- Evangelicals numbered 89 million (2.9%) in 1960, but by 2010 they were 546 million (7.9%)!

Iran

More Iranians came to Christ between 1980 and 2010 than the previous 1,000 vears combined.

India

In east India many of Nagaland's three million people confess Jesus as Lord. The Nagaland church recently vowed to send out 10,000 new missionaries to India and beyond. Those once unreached are now becoming senders.

Israel / Jews

More Jews have embraced Jesus / Yeshua as Messiah since 1967 when the Jews took control of Jerusalem than in all the years between 100 AD and 1967.

Nepal

In the early 1980s there were only 75 known Nepali believers. Today there are an estimated 850,000 believers. There were almost no churches 20 years ago but nearly 10,000 churches and house fellowships today.

South Korea

Once deemed "impossible to penetrate" by missionaries, Korea has experienced dramatic church growth in the last century. Today Korea is 30% Christian with over 3,000 churches in Seoul alone. Several of these churches have over one million members each.

In 1950, when China closed to missionaries,

there were about one million Chinese

million believers and over 10,000 new Christians in China every day! There are more followers of Christ in China than in

North America.

believers. Today some estimate over 75

Afghanistan

Until very recently becoming a Christian was close to a death sentence. Now missionaries in Kabul report unprecedented openness and many new believers in the last several years.

In 1960 only about 5% of southern

Sudan was Christian. Today, after

Turkey

Christianity in Turkey say they came to Christ because he appeared to them in a dream. God is at work even where there are no missionaries!

One third of the converts to

20,000 new African believers every day. From 3% Christian in 1900, some countries in Africa today are more than 50% Christian. The church in Africa is growing four times faster than the general population. Sub-Sahara Africa is becoming a sending base for missionaries to Islamic North Africa.

FRANCE

FRANCE TOTAL POPULATION: 62,636,580. CHRISTIAN: 61.1% MUSLIM: 10.5% NON-RELIGIOUS: 26% JEWISH: 1%

Prophetic word

Colin Dye received a word from God in the early 1990s that, "The [French] language that had blasphemed would be used by God to bring the gospel to the nations". It is our passion to see the French-speaking nations saved and used by the power of God.

"The Lord has been showing us for a long time that a time would come when France would be really 'down' and that God would use that tragedy to turn the hearts of the French people to him. We have never been nearer to that situation" Jean-Hugues Jequier (*Institut de Formation International de Marseille* Principal)

Update from Marseille

A number of former students trained at the *Institut de Formation International de Marseille* (IFIM) in Marseille are now working for God. One couple is leading a church in Limoges. Another student works in Burkina Faso, Africa. A couple are helping a church in Nice which goes each year to Constantine in Algeria. Natacha is working hard at the church plant in Marseille and Yann, from the town of Nancy, has already started a church and often visits Marseille to help us.

The Marseille population is 25% Muslim and only 1% evangelical Christian. Pray for a breakthrough. 120 years ago Ruben Saillens, an evangelist, spent 5 years in Marseille. After only one year of work they had opened 6 evangelistic centres with 1,250 seats, filled with people thirsty for God. They had a Bible School... so Marseille has a history of preaching the gospel!

Church Plant

A small team made up of two former students and some of the second year students with Jean-Hugues and his wife are planting a KT church in an area of Marseille. Recently they held an *Alpha* course and 5 new people came who had not been to church before. They have seen 4 new people come to faith in Christ in the past 3 months.



"One new man came to our Sunday gathering. He had been invited to church on the bus by one of the team after he saw them reading a book called "Intimacy with God". This interested him as he had spent 11 years in prison where he found Jesus. Now 1 year out of prison, he had no church but a real thirst for God. During the meeting he gave his testimony, we were moved to tears. After we prayed for him he was filled with the presence of God."

Update from Paris - David and Christine Thabot

David and Christine spent three months earlier this year helping to change the political tide in their region. In the last couple of years more than 80 churches have been closed by anti-Christian administrative and political pressure. The elections proved that their work was worth it as a more conservative party has won and the pressure has partly gone. At the same time, the building run by David is welcoming many churches every weekend that otherwise could not have any place of worship.

Colin Dye has had the opportunity this year to minister to a large Romanian church that has grown to 500 people and is currently meeting in the Temple du Paris building. It is great to hear that churches are growing in Paris despite the recent persecution.

- Pray for new people who are sold out for God and ready to come to the Marseille Bible school in September.
- Pray for new churches in the francophone world that would receive a heart for Marseille and send people for training to partner with us.
- Pray for the church planting team and for the church to grow.
- Pray for Jean-Hugues and Elisabeth for wisdom and strength to lead the IFIM Bible school and raise up workers for the French harvest field.
- Pray against the rise of Islam in France and for Christians to have influence in the government.
- Pray for David and Christine Thabot for strength and that God would raise up leaders in the Temple du Paris.
- Pray against secularism within the government and that our Paris church would be delivered from persecution by the authorities in order to grow to its full potential.

ALGERIA

ALGERIA TOTAL POPULATION: 35,422,589. MUSLIM: 97.29% NON-RELIGIOUS: 2.40% CHRISTIAN: 0.28% BAHA'I 0.01%



KTLCC is partnering with Pastor Youssef, who is planting many new churches and raising up lesders in Algeria. As a result the Algerian believers have now managed to build a Bible school and training centre for people who are called to the ministry. This has provided students the opportunity to study God's Word in Arabic and the Kablye language.

This training has meant that the number of churches being opened across the Kabyle region doubled in 2013. In the month of May over 19 youth were baptised at the beach after they responded to the message in the service.

In May 2013, Colin Dye led a conference, equipping the church in Algeria to have a passion for missions. Following this, so far in 2014, more than 90 people have shown an interest in becoming long or short term missionaries in their nation.

An outpouring of God's Spirit

As God has been pouring his Spirit among the nation of Algeria, the church of the Lord Jesus Christ has withstood the attack of the enemy. Today the church is flourishing like never before in Algeria, especially among the youth.

Healing Testimony

"I kept going to the mosque to find what my problems that I was suffering from, as I couldn't sleep, and had a symptom that doctors couldn't make me well. I heard that in the church healing was happening and I went to the church service, and when the pastor prayed for me I had a peace in my heart and I slept that night well. What amazed is that when I went to the doctors to find what was wrong, they saw that my symptoms had completely cleared away. I and nine members of my family came to church and have given our lives to Jesus!"

- Pray for peace to come on the nation of Algeria. Pray also for the hearts of those in government to turn towards the Lord.
- Pray for Pastor Youssef and the work he is doing in the nation of Algeria. Pray for the church growth that is taking place.
- Pray that more signs and wonders will manifest in the church in Algeria.
- Pray against persecution that is happening to Christians. Algerians who come to the knowledge of Jesus could end up losing their lives, their jobs or even becoming homeless and rejected by their families.
- Pray for the Tuareg and Bedouin peoples. Only a handful of believers were known just a few years ago. They are now rapidly responding to the gospel. Creative strategies are needed to effectively reach those who maintain the traditional nomadic lifestyle.

ROMANIA

ROMANIA TOTAL POPULATION: 21,190,154. CHRISTIAN: 96.96% NON-RELIGIOUS: 2.39%



Partnership with Betelem Church Medgiddia

Pastor Vasilica Croitor is the Pastor and Overseer for the churches that KT is partnering with in Romania, in the unreached region of Constanta. Altogether he is looking after a group made up of 8 mother churches and 16 daughter churches. The vision they received from the Lord is to plant a total of 44 new churches in an area dominated by the Greek Orthodox Church and Islam that is largely unreached by the gospel. In some areas there are no Christian churches. They have called the project of church planting *Constanta 2022*.

In the past year Vasilica and his team have hosted three missions teams with 55 people from KT, made up of pastors, cell leaders, cell members, IBIOL students and doctors. The result is that souls have been saved, the poor have been clothed and materials are being supplied for the leaders in the church in Romania. These spearhead missions have released KT people who have never been on a mission before onto the frontline in Romania and have helped strengthen the partnership between KT and the churches of Romania.



Pastor Florian with the car that was provided for him following the KTLCC Missions Month in July 2013 "God started moving powerfully right from day one when our team with Kristian Lythe went to Cobadin Church to minister to a small group of Turkish people mainly from Muslim background.

We shared testimonies about our own salvation stories and how we experienced the baptism of the Holy Spirit. Kristian preached on repentance and the power of the Holy Spirit. He made an altar call for people to come for prayer. I was amazed and excited to see people broken with tears streaming down their eyes and hungry for God. People came out for different needs. We prayed for the sick and laid hands on them. Kristian prayed for a woman with a broken wrist

in a splint and she immediately got better and testified that she could move her hand without pain."

- Pray for a great harvest in the nation of Romania.
- Pray for jobs for Christians who are currently unemployed. Unemployment is affecting over 75% of the population in the Constanta region.
- Pray for the church to continue to grow and reachot to the community and that people will abandon lawlessness, drugs and unbelief for the gospel.
- Pray for Pastor Vasilica to be encouraged in the work that God has appointed him to do.
- Pray for more KT people to sign up for short term missions and to go out into the mission field of Romania to witness.
- Pray for provision to be supplied to the Constanta church for training and equipping.

BRAZIL

BRAZIL TOTAL POPULATION: 195,423,252. CHRISTIAN: 91.40% NON-RELIGIOUS: 2.24%



KT involvement in Brazil

Our Senior Minister, Colin Dye, has been ministering in Brazil since the early 1990s, speaking at the 2 million strong March for Jesus and bringing apostolic input to key national church groups there. KT has a thriving Brazilian ministry here in London and from that we have begun to encourage new churches in strategic cities in that nation. One of the key church plants we have supported is in Recife where they have set up a church 'Novo Tempo' on the borders of a very needy favela (slum). As well as winning the lost, the church gives food, clothing and medical assistance to the poor. Finance is needed to expand this powerful ministry.

The Favelas (slums)

The church recently has seen a breakthrough in reaching out to the families of the favelas. When they first started the parents would send their children to the church but would not come themselves. But recently they have seen an increase of up to 200 children attending the outreach programs and activities, and the parents have also started coming to church themselves. They have seen many parents in the last couple of months give their lives to Jesus. Children have been evangelising their parents. This is so wonderful!

Sword of the Spirit Launch

Last year we raised £50,000 in our KT cell groups and missions month to send to Brazil in order to print and distribute the *Sword of the Spirit* manuals in Portuguese. Our aim is to use these books to launch a Bible school and to distribute these books all over Brazil to strengthen the work that God has been doing in reviving the church of Brazil.

Marcelo Albuquerque

Marcelo, Fabiana and their children have been working in Brazil for the last five years and are currently in transition as they are moving back to London to help strengthen the KTLCC network of churches and to build the Portuguese work in London.

Brazil IBIOL Mission

Last year our Senior Minister Colin Dye and Kristian Lythe led a team of IBIOL students to Brazil where

they recorded footage of the work Marcello is doing in Recife and heard about the vision to launch a Bible school in Sao Paolo. The team came back with awesome testimonies of God's healing power in the favelas.

A lady receives a new kidney!

One of the students prayed for a lady with a shrivelled kidney. She was on her way to get the kidney removed. After prayer for healing she noticed something was different in her body. She booked an appointment for a scan the next day to check if she had been healed. The scan came back to show her kidney had been completely restored!

- Pray for the *Sword of the Spirit* teaching ministry and materials to impact the churches of Brazil.
- Pray for the launch of the KT Bible school in Brazil.
- Pray for the KT Novo Tempo that they would disciple Brazilians living in London.
- Pray for the Recife church and all its leaders and members.
- Pray for God to grow the work in the favelas in Recife and use the 200 children to reach out to their families.

MUSLIM WORLD

NEARLY ONE QUARTER OF THE WORLD'S POPULATION TODAY IS MUSLIM. THE MUSLIM POPULATION IS A DIVERSE COMMUNITY OF ADHERENTS SPANNING THE GLOBE. OVER FIFTY COUNTRIES HAVE MUSLIM-MAJORITY POPULATIONS, WHILE OTHER GROUPS ARE CLUSTERED IN MINORITY COMMUNITIES ON NEARLY EVERY CONTINENT. ALTHOUGH ISLAM IS OFTEN ASSOCIATED WITH THE ARAB WORLD AND THE MIDDLE EAST, FEWER THAN 15% OF MUSLIMS ARE ARAB.



The Arab world has been greatly impacted by the programme and it is now airing in a brand new continent - Asia. Indonesia, which has the largest Muslim population in the world, now allows KingdomSat to be broadcast into all its homes.

I have just returned from preaching in Alexandria Egypt. There were many vacationing Egyptians who work in Saudi Arabia and other Gulf countries. With tears many of them said the Malakoot Sat has been an answer to years of prayer. They have no church, or Bible teachers in Arabia. Some told me of how much your ministry

really meant to them and that they will visit KT when in London. Thank you for your partnership in the Gospel to places that is so desperate for it.

We also desire to raise finance to plant hundreds of churches in certain Muslim majority nations. We have partners who are ready to train and send church planters in these nations' teams but they lack the resources to do it effectively. We also desire to raise more funds through GAP so that we can increase both the quality and quantity of our European and home missions reaching out across London and other key cities in Great Britain and Europe.

PRAYER FUEL

- Pray for revival in the Muslim nations today.
- Pray for more people to come into contact with El Malakoot in a lifetransforming way.
- Pray for a powerful witness of the love of Jesus to British Muslims to take place.
- Pray for KingdomSat that is now broadcasting in Indonesia, that God's anointing will continue to be upon it.
- Pray for Islamic extremists to come to the knowledge of Jesus
- Pray for the people that make that decisions for Christ as they watch the broadcast.

Islam in Europe

Islam is widely considered Europe's fastest growing religion. Immigration and above average birth rates leading to a rapid increase in the Muslim population. The exact number of Muslims is difficult to establish, however, as census figures are often questioned and many countries choose not to compile such information. God loves Muslims and we believe the Muslim world is ripe for a harvest. We believe that God has given KT a mandate not only to reach out in love to Muslims but also to explain the true nature of Islam to a very ignorant Western world. We have commissioned and written some key publications on Islam and we also have initiated the Institute for Islamic Studies and are working closely with believers in many parts of the Middle East to support and partner with them in the gospel.

We also are funding full time evangelists working in the Middle East to great effect. Limited financial support, aid and visits are given to persecuted Christians in hostile nations and we would very much like to increase this help through your faithful giving.

Colin Dye has a strong *Sword of the Spirit* teaching TV programme that is broadcast four times a day five times a week on free to air satellite to over 120 million homes throughout the Middle East and Africa. Colin Dye recently received an email from Dr Michael Youssef who runs the El Malakoot (KingdomSat) satellite channel broadcasting Christian teaching into the Arabic nations.

MALI

MALI TOTAL POPULATION: 13,323,104 MUSLIM: 87.38% ETHNO RELIGIONIST: 9.88% CHRISTIAN: 2.64% NON-RELIGIOUS: 0.1%



KT mission teams have been going to Mali since the year 2000 when we received a word from God to reach out to nations in the 10/40 window. Teams have been led by Dr Kemi Ajayi, Tayo Awoyera and Kristian Lythe to prepare the way for breakthrough in the nation. For the past 5 years Kemi has been working closely with the churches in Mali to launch a KT Bible school in the long term.

Kemi Ajayi and Team:

Kemi and a small team visited Mali this year in March to support the local pastors and to minister at the 19th anniversary of Oasis, the group of churches being pastored by Osakue and Marie Akioya. A five-day convention was held on the occasion which was attended by Oasis members in Mali and from the various villages where they have established congregations. They ministered during the sessions during the day as well as in the evening. The sessions were attended by most of the pastors we have been working with in Mali over the years. It was a good reunion.

Please continue to pray as we seek the Lord for the continuation of the work. We have had two years' delay and the urgency is even more pronounced than ever before.

Church attendance has risen

London has seen an increase of about 14.5% from the previous year in attendance at Christmas services, reaching a total of 2,618,030. Christenings are up 4.3%, adult baptisms are up 5% and thanksgivings for the birth of a child posted an 11.9% increase.

Average weekly attendance nationally fell by less than half of one per cent (0.3%) to 1,091,484, which represents a stabilising of average weekly attendance figures. Almost half of the Church of England's regional areas saw growth in church attendance, with 20 out of 44 dioceses showing increases. Better news was that nationally there was a 1.2% increase in children and young people attending to 216,928.

Grace for the City

On the evening of Friday 2nd October 1998 at Wembley Arena our first Grace for the City event took place. That evening Colin Dye publicly shared a vision regarding London that he'd carried in his spirit for seven years.

The vision was of a great angel towering over the city of London carrying a huge bowl full of golden liquid. The bowel was the size on the inside of the M25 that circles our capital. At first Colin feared that this bowl was full of judgement about to be poured out on our wicked city.

Pastor Claudio Ferro was sent by Kensington Temple in 2001 to Rome to start a church. That congregation now numbers around 40 people, and in 2014 they have planted another church in Viterbo, a town known as "the city of the popes". The work of planting churches moved them to new areas of Italy where there is no evangelical testimony - such as in some parts of Umbria. There they are evangelising and planting new cells.

We pray that by the end of this year a new church will be planted in Lubriano. For the summer Claudio has planned evangelistic open air crusades to take place during the local festivals that are crowded in the evenings and to have Bible seminars like "The end of time" in theatres, libraries and cultural festivals. This is a great tool to present the Word of God outside the Church.

KT's influence has grown in Italy through the many conferences that Colin has held in Milan, Rome, Catania, Pescara and Palermo. One of the most powerful of all was in Palermo Sicily with Colin Dye and Joseph Prince in 2011 with thousands attending.

Another great influence has come through the publishing the *Sword of the Spirit* series in Italian. They are used in many Bible schools and churches throughout the nation along with books like *Satan Unmasked* and *Mastering Your Emotions*.

Also, through the cell vision and making disciples KT has now two churches in Italy. Probably the greatest success of KT's mission to Italy is that after 13 years of ministry in Rome and the nation the work is growing and influencing many. This is unusual because the average life of a missionary or mission in Rome is 2 to 5 years, after that they withdraw because of lack of results. We give thanks for the grace of God and the power of the prayers and support of Kensington Temple and Colin Dye because after 13 years the work in Italy is growing and prospering.

- Pray for the *Sword of the Spirit* teaching to continue to be a great teaching resource in Italy.
- Pray for our churches in Rome and Viterbo to multiply and prosper, and for Claudio Ferro and his team that lead them.
- Pray for the new areas we are working (Orvieto to Viterbo) where many small towns have no evangelical testimony and the people rooted in Catholicism.
- Pray for the churches in Sicily.
- Pray for an outpuring of the Holy Spirit among the youth.
- Pray for God to send workers for evangelism. Because christians are so few it is difficult to organise evangelistic events and to have impact.
- Pray that signs and miracles will attract the attention of the Catholics and are a good testimony to the living God, so pray that they will accompany our preaching.
