We launched an innovative way of staying in touch every day. Our newly-named live streaming service, KTTV presents scheduled programme every day. It begins with live daily devotions at 9am with Colin and Amanda. Prayer and praise requests come in every day and are prayed for on the livestream as well as by the pastoral team and intercessors

Perhaps people thought that once we could not hold services in the KT building, the church would dissipate and people would lose heart. But the opposite is the case. We immediately switched from physical gatherings to online services. These are flourishing as members and guests stay loyal to their favourite service. We are grateful to RT Kendall who sends his messages on Colossians each week for us to broadcast on Sunday.

Not only are the services growing in attendance, but the church is receiving new members into the cells and various ministries. This is proving to be a time of growth and increase, despite the best efforts of our spiritual enemy to discourage and to diminish us. The Coronavirus crisis is proving to be a wake-up call for many inside and outside the church. People are seeking God in a new way. God is showing us a new understanding of what it means to be the church outside the walls of a building.

KT financial oversight

KT is governed by diligent financial oversight, both local and nationally. The annual accounts of both KT and the Network of LCC churches are audited twice each year. Firstly, external auditors visit KT and a number of Network churches every December. Then the entire Elim Pentecostal Church, of which KTLCC is a part, is audited as a single national charity. Elim's Annual Report and Accounts are publicly available at charitycommission.gov.uk Elim's charity registration number is 251549.

The Local Church Board holds both quarterly meetings and detailed special meetings where a detailed review of finance and accounts is always a major item on the agenda. We are available to and hold meetings with Elim's newly-formed Audit and Governance Committee where openness exists to answer any questions or provide any information and explanations requested on any matter.

This close liaison between Elim's national Financial Director, other Headquarters staff on the one hand, and with Jonathan Gwilt and local finance staff, on the other, ensures that KT operates under the highest standards of financial accountability.
