WORSHIP THE TRUE

n the Gospel record, Herod, a selfproclaimed Messiah and King of the Jews is confronted by the true King and Messiah. His drastic and murderous attempt to eradicate the baby Jesus reveals the battle in our own hearts as we are confronted by the Kingdom of God.

We are all familiar with political power struggles. They happen all over the world, no matter what the system of government democracy or dictatorship. But the biggest battle is between the kingdoms of this world and the kingdom of God.

King Herod saw the birth of Jesus as an existential threat to his power and position, and he simply had to try to eradicate that threat. He had the very best of this world - money, power, position and prestige. He got it by proclaiming himself the King of the Jews. He was claiming to be Messiah. But his kingdom was an ugly kingdom, played out on a sordid political stage. Closer to home, his reaction is an extreme example of the battle that goes on in all our hearts, daily.

As fallen human beings, our hearts clash with the heart of God and we sometimes fight tooth and nail to preserve our kingdom – the kingdom of Self. But we also know the sweet surrender when we embrace God's kingdom. We discover that it is not dreadful and forbidding, but enriching and uplifting. That is why we can speak of the Good News of the Kingdom.

There are (ultimately) only two kingdoms – the kingdom of God and kingdom of Self. Through Christ, we have been delivered from our own selfish, self-destructive kingdom and have been transferred into the other kingdom – God's kingdom of light, of love, of hope, of freedom and of peace.

That's why we celebrate the coming of Jesus into the world this holiday season and every other day of our lives. We choose to bow down and worship Jesus as our true Lord and Messiah.




